I have a request to submit to the INAIC Council on behalf of the DNS Operations Working Group. The request asks the INAIC Council to delegate the TLDs `101.` and `1-1.` to the DNS Operations Working Group. The two TLDs will be used to conduct tests and gather information on client and resolver support for numeric TLDs. These TLDs will be returned to the root once testing has been completed. These tests will provide Council with technical directions and guidance on the delegation and the technical limitations of numeric based TLDs in the DNS.
